A journey into darkness flowing through the underground dimensions of those nightmares that haunts us - fear as a creation of our minds-; upsetting stories told to her students by a mysterious philosophy professor at a university. Each story vividly reflects the thoughts of old and modern philosophers about fear, exposing different dimensions within the hell of horror.

Storyline

Sofia is a philosophy teacher that uses great sages' phrases intertwined with stories to teach about horror and life. Each individual episode, based on urban and local myths and legends, depicts Mexican and human race's deepest fears. Each one is part of an anthology of fear that allows us, through every episode's beginning to end, showing something about Sofia's vision of life. Fear is set off through suspense rather than by using gore visuals, on our mind's imagination, rather than visual and audio FXs, on the way images and sound mirror horror. Sofia starts taletelling her stories with old or modern famous philosophers' sayings that catchphrases what the fiction is about - Sophocles up to Jean Paul Sartre, including nowadays thinkers like Neil deGrasse Tyson. This anthology of horror is intimately linked to Sofia's secret past. Throughout each episode we will subtly discover her own hell, her worst nightmares: aging - in every new deliver she seems older. Her mom wrote the anthology, and Sofia must now add a new story to recover her youth, for only consuming her story's victim's horror (one of her students) might she live forever.

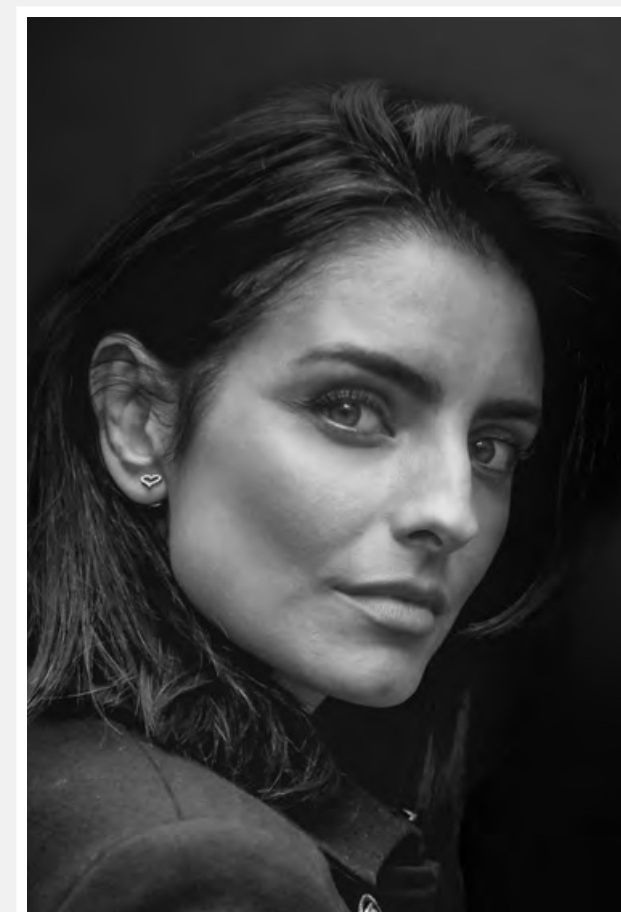
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
