He's naïve and almost devoted to Caco.



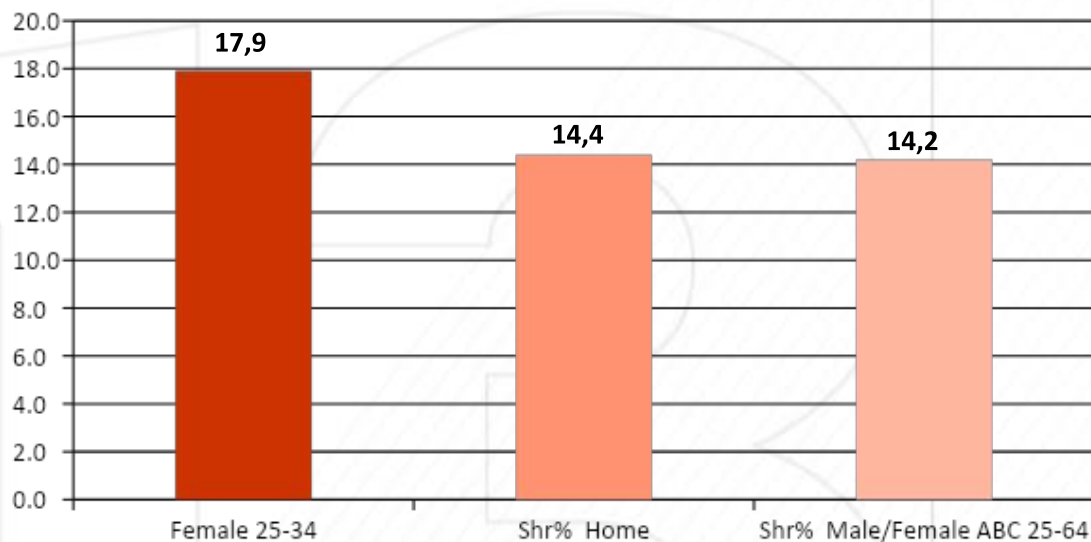
